## **Exam Room/Visitor Policy**

Ultrasound is an extremely user dependant imaging modality and requires a high degree of concentration with a minimum amount of distractions desired. Providing quality medical care with the best possible patient experience remains our goal. Because of our mission, the following policies have been adopted to ensure the highest quality Ultrasound exams possible:

### **1. Observation by family and friends:**

- During Diagnostic Obstetrical ultrasounds, a maximum of two adults will be allowed in the room during exam.
- Only the patient will be allowed into the exam room during all other ultrasound exams, with the exception of minor patients, care givers or interpreters.
- We cannot allow unsupervised children under the age of 7 years old in the exam room. We do, however, provide flexible weekend and evening appointments.

### **2. Cameras during diagnostic ultrasounds:**

- Cameras and camcorders are extremely distracting and are not allowed in the room during the exam.
- Patients who are pregnant will be given a complimentary photo of their baby.
- Cell phone use is not allowed in the exam rooms.
